From the DKF (formally GCBF)...

The Diabetic Kids Fund is formally known as the Grand Council Benevolent Fund, Inc (GCBF). The fund supports the "Camperships" which are the registration fees for "Kids" with diabetes to go to Camps in Ohio. Monies from the GCBF are given to the Camps based upon their need and efforts to use them only for the "Kids" who could not otherwise afford to go. That fee is now about \$700 per "Kid" in most Camps in Ohio. Last week the GCBF presented a check for \$25,000 to the Camp in Geauga County known as Ho Mita Koda. It has existed since 1929.

Since its inception in 1977 the GCBF has distributed over \$1.5 million to the Ohio Camps for the "Kids." All money raised by the Companions, Councils, Arches and their friends and family are given out. No money is spent on administration or postage, etc. All money collected by the Companions and the Councils is to get to the Grand Recorder by May 31 of this year to be considered part of this Cryptic Year's efforts of the Councils.
